

Risk Management on the (ROL)



- As a reminder, RM approved means a referee has been live scanned (digitally fingerprinted) **AND** we have received the approval results back from the Department of Justice.
- Only those 18 and older must get their live scan done as they are now legal adults. Minors are automatically considered RM Approved until they turn 18. Once 18, they are given a 90 day grace period to get the service done.
- A referee having gone through the live scan service does not mean we have the results yet. On average, it takes 14 days from the date of service to get an approval result back.



Risk Management on the (ROL)



- It is important that each referee use their legal name as stated on their legal identification card. The RM approval results come back with their legal name. If they registered for their certification year under a nick name, RM department will not be able to make a match. This will delay their approval from reflecting on their profile.
- Minors close to becoming 18 are sent emails from Cal South to remind them to get the live scan done once they turn 18 along with instructions.
- Once the 90 day grace period passes for those minors who recently turned 18, Cal South will need to remove them from the ROL. One last email will be sent to the referee letting them know they have been temporarily removed along with instructions on how to get live scanned.
- Once their approval results are in, we will place them back on the ROL and mail out an updated Referee ID.
