- Interested new State Instructor candidates must be nominated by their SDI to U.S. Soccer and U.S. Soccer must approve the nomination
- To successfully complete the course, candidates must demonstrate comprehensive knowledge of the subject matter and display effective practical skills as evaluated and determined by the course instructor(s) assigned by U.S. Soccer
- The minimum passing test score is 80% and all testing requirements can be completed online and/or in the classroom setting as determined by the State Referee Association
